Questions:

How old is Ali? (1 mark)

Who does Ali live with? (1 mark)

What does Ali like to eat? (1 mark)

Encourage students to respond in complete sentences instead of one word answers. They can look at the paragraph if they like.

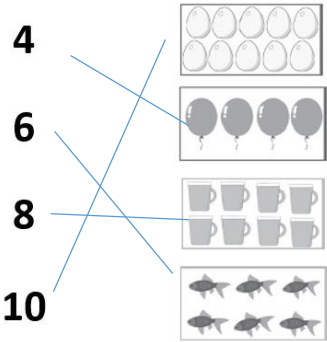
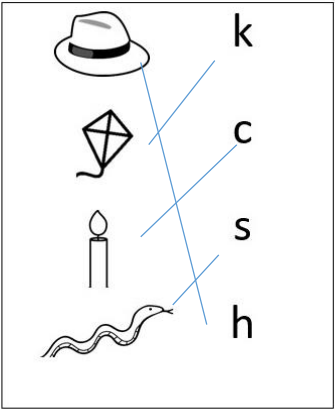


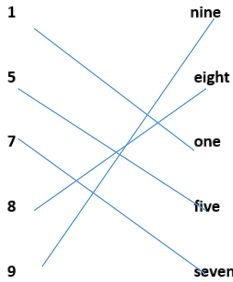
